The Celebration Choir will be meeting at 7 pm on Wednesday, July 20. Regular weekly rehearsals will resume in August –

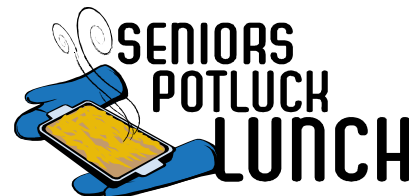
Wednesdays at 7 pm. Everyone is invited to come join us.

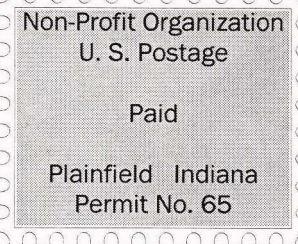

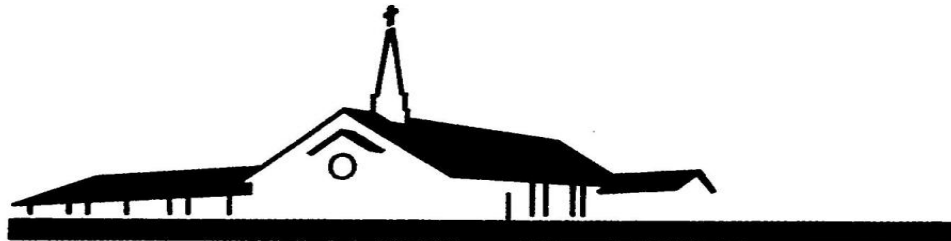
